

Ravenglass & Eskdale Railway Route Map



Emergency Procedure – If a medical emergency please contact the Emergency Services directly.

1. Start/End – From the station take the ramp southwards towards the bridge over the main trainline. This section is narrow and can be busy – please use tortoise mode and give way to other users.

2. No Access over Bridge while repairs under taken please follow 2a.

2a. Alternative route to Ravenglass village and shoreline

Through the railway carpark and turn left onto the road and under the bridge. Both these sections are on road open to traffic. Please follow instructions as per point 3 below.

- 3. Roads The route uses public roads, please be aware of other road users when crossing or traveling on the village road/car park. When traveling on the road please stay on the left and travel in single file. If descending or ascending onto a pavement via a curb (not dropped) please ensure you approach at a 45 degree angle and NOT head on.
- **4. Beach DO NOT take the Tramper on the beach.** It will get stuck. Off the Main Street is the Millenium Garden which is a small courtyard. This can be accessed on the Tramper but is narrow so please take care and proceed in tortoise mode.
- **5. Promenade** The promenade can be accessed from the North end. **Keep the Tramper 3m away from the edge.** If there has been lots of rain and the ground is not firm, please do not take the Tramper on the promenade as it will damage the grass.
- **6. Access to Ratty Arms** Ensure the Tramper is not taken indoors if stopping at any of the locations in Ravenglass and if the Tramper is left that it is done in an appropriate location and the key is removed.
- 7. To the Roman Bath House Return to the station and take the pathway up the ramp, turn left at the top (right over the bridge is closed). This area is narrow and can be busy so please use Tortoise mode. At point 7 you join the road and turn right following the Eskdale trail. Be aware of other road users when joining the road and stay on the left-hand side.
- **8. Eskdale Trail** After 100m you leave the road and follow the Eskdale Trail sign. This leads you off road to the Roman Bath House.
- 9. Roman Bath House Return point.
